

Range/Course Safety rules:

- A. No cross-shooting. (target range)
- B. No broadheads permitted on practice range. Broadheads may only be shot in designated broadhead area.
- C. All youth less than 18 years of age must be directly supervised by an adult; supervising adult is responsible for conduct of youth. No unsupervised youth will be allowed to shoot.
- D. Minimum arrow or bolt length is 20 inches.
- E. Limit of 6 arrows or bolts per practice round.
- F. All shooters must remain behind firing line on practice range.
- G. Recurves and compounds must be drawn in a safe and controlled manner. Crossbows may not be cocked until shooter is on shooting line or at stake on course. Crossbows must be loaded in a downrange direction. No crossbow will be loaded in an upward pointing direction.
- H. All shooters must shoot and pull arrows or bolts at same time, please announce 'all clear' before pulling arrows or bolts.
- I. Before pulling arrows or bolts, all shooters must place bows or crossbows on hangers and announce 'all clear'. Any shooter going behind target to retrieve arrow or bolt must activate safety indicator, and de-activate before returning to shooting line.
- J. No cocking of crossbows or placing of arrow on string until all shooters have returned to line and safety indicator is in safe position.
- K. All bows and crossbows must be hand held unless pre-approved by the Executive Council.

Rule violations should be reported to the Executive Council for review and may result in a verbal warning or expulsion from the club. Expulsion will be a minimum of 1 year. Any expelled member must retake a bowhunter or bow safety course and show proof of completion before being reconsidered for membership.
